GREG

Greg chuckles and wipes the make-up off. It was a joke.

GREG (cont'd)

I'm sorry. I have a twisted sense of humor.

Most of the class is relieved, but also a little freaked out. But Laurie smiles, finding it funny.

GREG (cont'd)
